

2018 SUMMER CAMP SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Thanks to Wild Birds Unlimited and an anonymous donor, Dogwood Canyon Audubon Center is providing funds for five children from eligible families to participate in Camp Cedar Hill Summer Camp at Dogwood Canyon Audubon Center at no cost. Each scholarship covers one child's registration fees and tuition for one week of camp.

If the recipient family requires extended care, the cost of \$25/week is to be paid at the time of registration. Additional purchases and any applicable fees incurred due to late pick-up or other infractions are the responsibility of the recipient family. Additionally, transportation to and from Dogwood Canyon Audubon Center must be provided by the family.

PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING TERMS AND CONDITIONS BEFORE APPLYING FOR FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:

* To apply for financial assistance, you must complete and submit this form **BEFORE REGISTERING ONLINE**. **Submit your scholarship application at least seven days in advance of your intent to register a child in summer camp to allow processing time. Please submit applications earlier when possible.**

* If approved, a unique coupon code will be emailed to the e-mail address provided on the application. **PLEASE NOTE: The coupon code will expire after two days, so registration must be completed quickly upon notification of the award.** The coupon code is for use only by the awarded scholarship recipient. It may not be transferred, sold or shared in any way.

* Please note that proof of household income via a previous year tax return and/or the previous month's pay stub(s) must be provided if requested by Dogwood Canyon Audubon Center in order for assistance to be granted. In order to expedite processing, applicants may choose to provide this information at the time of application.

* Please note that we require completion of a separate application form for each child. Each child may be awarded only one scholarship per summer.

* It is a requirement of participation in the scholarship program that children who are selected for the scholarship may be part of a Wild Birds Unlimited publicity campaign. The child's image (photo/video) may be made public through email newsletters, advertisements, press releases as well as television and newspaper stories.

* As an additional requirement, **you and your camper must each provide a letter (the child may alternatively submit artwork) describing how the Audubon camp was important and what the favorite aspect of the camp was (i.e., fun experience, what was learned, interactions with nature, etc.). This must be turned in no later than the Friday morning of the camp week for which the scholarship is used.** Please note that failure to provide the letter and artwork will result in the revocation of the scholarship, an invoice for the registration fee and tuition, and will bar the child from being considered for scholarships in the future.

* By accepting the scholarship, permission is granted to Audubon and Wild Birds Unlimited to copy and/or reproduce your camper's artwork or other projects. We may share any of the above with funders and/or the public, but names will remain anonymous.

The funds for our scholarships come primarily from **Wild Birds Unlimited** and **donations to Dogwood Canyon Audubon Center, Audubon Texas and National Audubon Society, Inc. (collectively "Audubon").**
